3. For Patient Conduction OUTSIDE AOR (outside San Juan City).

These services cater to the constituents that are suffering from long-term or chronic illnesses but are <u>NOT</u> in an emergency situation. They are in need of transportation assistance due to their physical and/ or medical conditions (e.g. comatose and bed ridden patients)

Any patient under emergency condition will not fall in this category and will immediately be transported to the **nearest** hospital for medical treatment.
