

8. AVAILING OF VISUAL INSPECTION WITH ACETIC ACID (VIA) SCREENING

VIA Screening is a simple, inexpensive test with moderate sensitivity for testing that can be combined with simple treatment procedures for early cervical lesions. This healthcare service involves inserting a vaginal speculum and swabbing the cervix with 3% to 5% acetic acid solution before doing a cervical inspection, and being conducted only by professional healthcare provider/s.
